

ABSENTEE BALLOT APPLICATION:

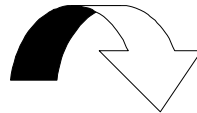
Civilian Absentee ballots are available to voters who will not be able to vote in person on election day due to one of the following reasons:

- Expect to be absent from the State of New Jersey on election day
- Illness or temporary physical disability
- Permanently and totally disabled
- Observance of a religious holiday on election day
- Resident attendance at a school, college or university on election day
- Nature and hours of my employment on election day

A voter may apply for an absentee ballot by completing an Absentee Ballot Application and mailing the application to their **County Clerk** by mail up to 7 days prior to the election. A voter may also apply in person to the County Clerk until 3:00 p.m., the day before the election.

The County Clerk cannot accept faxed copies of an Absentee Ballot Application since an original signature is required.
